Who will build a 50 MW solar power plant in Angola?

The Italian company ENI signed a concession agreement with the government for the construction of a 50 MW solar plant in Namibe province, in southwestern Angola. The solar power plant will be constructed by Solenova, a joint venture between ENI and Angolan state-owned oil producer Sonangol.

Is there solar power in Angola?

Plenty of rivers in Angola," says Somoil CEO, Edson dos Santos. Total's Olivier Jouin also says the firm is aiming at a range of renewable power sources in Angola. "Here in Angola, we see in particular a very strong potential for solar power. We currently have a solar project in the town of Lubango, in Huila province, in the south of Angola.

Will Angola become the largest oil producer in southern Africa?

The International Energy Agency says Angola is set to become the largest crude oil producer in Southern Africa, with a foundation for renewable energy, through investments and supportive measures. TotalEnergies is the largest oil and gas producer in Angola, where the government is encouraging more investment to expand that production.
