

Can a suitcase be used for storage when it is not in use

Should you store your luggage upright or flat?

Storing luggage upright is generally recommended as it helps maintain the shape and prevents unnecessary pressure on one side. However, if space is an issue, flat storage can work too, just be sure not to stack heavy items on top of your suitcases to avoid crushing them. If you have empty wall space either in your closet or in a utility pantry, consider hanging your luggage from pegs or hooks up high. This storage method conserves space, but it's important to keep your suitcase as light as possible to avoid damaging the handles. Don't nest suitcases in each other, and ensure the luggage is empty.
