Hydroelectric power currently stands as one of the most prominent energy sources in Eswatini. The EEC operates four hydropower plants, constituting 15% of the country's electricity production and plans to bolster the existing infrastructure.

The power plant, which tracks the sun from morning to sunset, generates a capacity of 13.75MW and contributes a guaranteed capacity of 10MW to EEC's power grid.
