Is a solar park in French Guiana ready for green hydrogen production?

French hydrogen technologies developer HDF Energy (EPA: HDF), investment fund Meridiam and petroleum operator SARA have launched construction of a solar park with batteries and 16 MW of electrolyzers for green hydrogen production in French Guiana.

How will EDF power French Guiana?

It will be connected to French Guiana's electricity grid through EDF's substation in Saint-Laurent-du-Maroni. The facility will provide reliable and clean electricity to power up to 10,000 French Guiana households. It will meet half of the energy demand in Saint-Laurent-du-Maroni and the Mana commune of French Guiana.

How does ceog fit with French Guiana's energy strategy?

The population of French Guiana is very quickly increasing. Guiana has to face a considerable energy deficit, especially in the west where the demographic growth is booming. By providing several MW of reliable and clean energy, CEOG fits with French Guiana's energy strategy.

How much daylight does French Guiana have?

French Guiana is situated in northern South America, close to the equator. It, therefore, boasts 12 hours of daylight throughout the year, which will allow the CEOG solar-cum-green hydrogen power project to operate consistently as a baseload facility all year round.

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The solar-plus-storage facility should help replace existing diesel generators in Saint Laurent du Maroni, a border town in northwest French Guiana. Voltalia expects Sable Blanc to go online by end-2022. Once up and running, it will increase the capacity of the Toco energy storage complex to 19.3 MW/25.6 MWh.

EnerVenue has launched an integrated energy storage system (ESS) solution comprised of its metal-hydrogen batteries, which it claims are capable of 30,000 cycles or more. The firm announced the launch of its EnerVenue Energy Rack yesterday (30 November), comprised of its Energy Storage Vessels (ESVs) in 150kWh and 102kWh configurations.

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A second installation phase has been completed at TotalEnergies' battery energy storage facility in Dunkirk, northern France, bringing its output and capacity to 61MW / 61MWh. The battery energy storage system (BESS) was already France's biggest system of its type -- at 25MW / 25MWh -- when it was inaugurated in January 2021.

Voltalia currently has six renewable energy power plants in French Guiana (three solar, two biomass and one hydroelectric) as well as battery storage units with a total installed capacity of 30 megawatts, producing the equivalent of nearly 10% of the electricity consumed on the coast of French Guiana.
