ONE OF THE MOST remote spots on Earth,the French Southern Territories consists of three groups of islands in the southern INDIAN OCEAN,not too far from the coast of ANTARCTICA,and a thin slice of the Antarctic continent itself,known as Adelie Land.

Because of their isolation and subpolar location,the French Southern Lands are relatively depauperate of vegetation,with both Saint-Paul and Crozet having no native tree or shrub species. However,eight of the 36 higher plant species are endemic.
