Will I be notified if I enroll in a community solar program?

Due to limited availability, enrollment does not guarantee your participation, and acceptance into the program will be subject to verification by Georgia Power. You will be notified of program enrollment prior to your first Community Solar billing. If enrollment exceeds availability, you will automatically be added to a waiting list.

By last year, Georgia was home to more than 300,000 residential solar energy systems. And the local solar market is only set to grow in the next half-decade. Introduced by the City of Savannah's Office of Sustainability in September, the Georgia BRIGHT solar lease program will be offering a new incentive through the end of year.
