

How long can a Japanese locker last

How long can you use a coin locker in Japan?

If you're planning to use the locker for more than 24 hours, you'll need to factor in the additional fees. Also, don't forget to retrieve your items before leaving the area, as unclaimed items may be removed by the staff after 2-3 days, or up to 30 days, depending on the company. Using a coin locker in Japan is very simple.

What time do you need a locker in Japan?

Also, big lockers are rarer, and usually, they are fully used before 11 a.m., so if you need one for large luggage, you have to get up early to give yourself the best chance of finding one available to use. How Much is The Locker Fee in Japan? Coin locker fees vary depending on the size of the locker.

How long does a locker last?

Maximum storage time is usually 3-4 days. After this limit, the management company will open the locker and confiscate your items, holding them for up to a month. You'll need to pay both the regular locker fees plus a separate storage charge to get your belongings back. Prohibited items in lockers include:

Are coin lockers safe in Japan?

Coin lockers can come in incredibly handy when you're traveling, allowing you to store your luggage before heading to the airport or secure heavy items when out and about shopping. So if you want to take advantage of convenient and safe coin lockers while in Japan, we've created a basic guide to help you use them.

What size coin lockers are available in Japan?

Coin lockers in Japan are available in various sizes, with some differences in dimensions and fees depending on the location and manufacturer. For your reference, coin lockers installed at JR stations are usually the following sizes: Small lockers are ideal for backpacks or totes but you'll probably need a medium-size locker for small suitcases.

How much does a Japanese station locker cost?

Japanese station lockers come in two main varieties: key-operated and keyless. Key-operated lockers are straightforward to use - simply insert your coins, lock the door, and keep the key with you. These lockers typically only accept 100-yen coins, with fees ranging from 200-400 yen for small sizes, 400-600 yen for medium, and 600-800 yen for large.

Especially in very busy periods, if you need a large coin locker in a certain place it is good to go very early in the morning because there is a risk that they are all full. In huge stations like Shinjuku, Tokyo Station or Kyoto Station, there are ...

The words 1-Day ?? Yen, translated to "1-Day ?? Yen" indicates the daily usage fee for each coin locker. Note that prices displayed are not for 24 hour use but up till the time of day determined for each locker. Make sure to
