Who owns Mauritania's electricity plant?

Completed in 2017, the \$53 million plant is run by the national electricity company, Sociéte Nationale d'Electricité (Sonelec), and has seen ongoing works since its inauguration by (then) President Mohamed Ould Abdel Aziz, removing an estimated 57,000 tonnes of CO₂ per annum and supplying 10% of Mauritania's net energy production.

Does Mauritania have solar?

TOUJOUNINE - Solar Averaging seven days of rain a year, Mauritania's climate is ideal for solar and the country's first major development in the sector did not disappoint in this regard with 54,000 panels supporting 50 MW production capacity at Toujounine, on the northern outskirts of the nation's capital.

What is Mauritania's largest wind farm?
