

What is Eswatini famous for?

Eswatini's most well-known cultural event is the annual Umhlanga Reed Dance. In the eight-day ceremony, girls cut reeds, present them to the Queen Mother and then dance bare-breasted. It is done in late August or early September. Only childless, unmarried girls can take part.

Is Eswatini a member of the United Nations?

Eswatini is a member of the United Nations, the Commonwealth of Nations, the African Union, the Common Market for Eastern and Southern Africa, and the Southern African Development Community. [83 ][84 ][85 ][86 ][87 ]As of 2024, it is the only country in Africa that has maintained ties with Taiwan and not the People's Republic of China.

What countries does Eswatini trade with?

Eswatini's major overseas trading partners are the United States [18 ] and the European Union. [19 ] The majority of the country's employment is provided by its agricultural and manufacturing sectors. Eswatini is a member of the Southern African Development Community, the African Union, the Commonwealth of Nations, and the United Nations.

Is Eswatini a member of CITES?

[65 ] Eswatini is a signatory to the Convention on Biological Diversity, the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species (CITES), and the United National Framework Convention on Climate Change.

What currency does Eswatini use?

Eswatini is a developing country that is classified as having a lower-middle income economy. As a member of the Southern African Customs Union and the Common Market for Eastern and Southern Africa, its main local trading partner is South Africa; to ensure economic stability, Eswatini's currency, the lilangeni, is pegged to the South African rand.

What is Eswatini's economy like?

Eswatini's economy is diverse, with agriculture, forestry and mining accounting for about 13% of GDP, manufacturing (textiles and sugar-related processing) representing 37% of GDP and services - with government services in the lead - constituting 50% of GDP.
