

Should you visit Saint-Pierre & Miquelon?

A trip to the French islands of Saint-Pierre and Miquelon is a must for anyone planning travel in eastern Newfoundland. With a piece of Europe just 20 km from the province's southern coast, why wouldn't you plan an international trip? That being said, a visit to the archipelago does require some preparation.

What is the difference between Miquelon and Saint-Pierre?

Miquelon -- the larger island (actually three of them, connected by drifted sand) and village, Basque and Acadian history, and a large amount of wildlife, small farming operations and summer homes. Saint-Pierre -- the smaller island, the only significantly populated town (the capital), and the central area of activity.

Where is Saint Pierre & Miquelon located?

Saint Pierre and Miquelon are a small group of islands in the North Atlantic Ocean, south of Newfoundland and Labrador. First settled by the French in the early 17th century, the islands represent the sole remaining vestige of France's once vast North American empire, New France.

How did Saint-Pierre and Miquelon become a territory?

After the 1958 French constitutional referendum, the territory of Saint-Pierre and Miquelon was asked to choose one of three options: becoming fully integrated with France, becoming a self-governing state within the French Community, or preserving the status of an overseas territory; it decided to remain a territory.

Does Saint Pierre and Miquelon have a football team?

Saint Pierre and Miquelon has a domestic football league comprising three teams. Starting in 2018, local clubs have competed in France's domestic knockout cup, the Coupe de France. The territory also has a national team, but it is presently not a member of FIFA or CONCACAF. North American-style license plate in Saint-Pierre.

Does Saint-Pierre and Miquelon have a health care system?

Saint-Pierre and Miquelon's health care system is entirely public and free. In 1994, France and Canada signed an agreement allowing the residents of the archipelago to be treated in St. John's.
