

How much solar power does Guinea have?

Guinea had an installed PV capacity of just 13 MW at the end of 2020. Infracore Africa, a unit of U.K.-based Private Infrastructure Development Group (PIDG), and Solveo Energie, a unit of French renewable energy developer Solveo, have secured a 25-year power purchase agreement (PPA) for a large-scale solar project under development in Guinea.

What is the 88 MW solar project in Guinea?

The project is likely the first phase of an 88 MW PV project announced by the French government in April 2017. The French authorities said at the time that the project was expected to be built in two 44 MW phases and to be developed by Solveo Energie. Guinea has had very limited development of solar energy to date.

The battery is situated within Voltalia's Toco energy storage complex, touted as one of the largest ones of its kind in France with a capacity of 19 MW/27 MWh. At present, Voltalia operates 48 MW of solar, hydropower, biomass and energy storage assets in French Guiana. The firm started building Parc Sable Blanc in November 2011.
