

What are Bonaire & Sint Eustatius?

These are the islands of Bonaire, Sint Eustatius, and Saba, [10][nb 1] as they are also known in legislation, or the BES islands (an acronym of their names; most people believe, however, it's an acronym for 'Bijzondere Eilandelijke Status' meaning special island status) for short.

Who is the representative of Bonaire Sint Eustatius & Saba?

How much does energy cost in Bonaire?

Does EU law apply to Bonaire Islands?

The islands are officially classified as public bodies [11] in the Netherlands and as overseas territories of the European Union; as such, European Union law does not automatically apply to them. Bonaire (including the islet of Klein Bonaire) is one of the Leeward Antilles and is located close to the coast of Venezuela.

Does Bonaire have a regulated electricity sector?

In recent years, the Ministry of Economic Affairs in the Netherlands has been active in reforming the regulation of the electricity sector in Bonaire, both in terms of utility regulation and expanding generator access.¹³

Does Bonaire have a utility company?

The utility company for Bonaire is Water-En Energiebedrijf Bonaire N.V. (WEB), which supplies both water and electricity to the island. WEB is a government-owned entity and is strictly a distribution utility, owning no generation of its own.

In Bonaire, Sint Eustatius and Saba there are 93.52 people per square kilometers (0.386102 square miles), if spaced out evenly. 10.71 infants die at birth out of a 1000 new born in Bonaire, Sint Eustatius and Saba.
