Two2-KW of-grid photovoltaic (PV) systems are in operation at the University of Trinidad &Tobago and the Trinidad &Tobago Electricity Commission. Twenty-one 1-KW PV systems had also been installed at schools around the country by 2020. The electricity generation mix in Trinidad &Tobago is still dominated by fossil fuels.

Are there green energy sources in Trinidad & Tobago?

As there currently are not many green energy sources available in Trinidad & Tobago, local businesses must work towards developing their own and place additional emphasis on energy efficiency and conservation.
