Price of solar. Solar panel prices dropped two-thirds since early 2011. A 4kWp system (16 solar panels) that used to cost £15,000 is currently available from £5,000. On a South-facing roof these panels will pay back about £860 per year, which is a return of 17% on the purchase price.
