Which power station in Hong Kong uses natural gas?

First power station in Hong Kong to use natural gas for power generation. The use of natural gas reduced total emissions despite an 80% increase in electricity demand. Located in the New Territories, Black Point is one of the world's largest gas-fired combined-cycle power stations. It uses ultra low-sulphur diesel as a backup fuel source.

What was the first natural gas-fired power station in Hong Kong?

The Black Point 2,500MW combined cycle project was the first natural gas-fired power station in Hong Kong. When completed in 2004 it was one of the world's largest gas-fired combined cycle power stations.

Are there power stations in Hong Kong?

There are virtually no sites in Hong Kong that are readily useable for power stations and it has been necessary to excavate and reclaim to form suitable flat areas from rugged coastal terrain. The choice of Tap Shek Kok for the Castle Peak Power Station was no exception. This site was an area of land and sea bed, granted by Government in 1978.

Hinkley Point B is a nuclear power station near Bridgwater in Somerset. The station was the first Advanced Gas-cooled Reactor to generate electricity to the grid in the UK. ... Address: EDF Hinkley Point power station Nr Bridgwater ...
